

# GE specific budget

The 2021 budget for Development Education co-financing scheme is 605 000 euros.

The 2020 budget for Development Education co-financing scheme is 605 000 euros (Portugal Country Report 2020).

In 2019, the budget of the call for proposals was raised from 550 000 to 625 000 euros. (Portugal Country Report 2019).
